The Presidents Message

Hello,

Saturday October 3rd is the NSCA Registered Fall color Shoot. [Check our website for more details.](#)

Good news, with the exception of Harvest Dinners, our club just had its highest ever, single month of income in July, \$10,000. Attendance is up this summer.

Fifty eight Ruffed Grouse shooters started out with the threat of a rain fill day. At 9:30am the rain let up to the point that more water was falling from the trees than the sky. The balance of the day was rain free until after the shooting was over and the staff had reloaded all of the trap machines. Our prayers were answered. Everyone enjoyed a cool overcast day for shooting clay targets and the lunch. Several prizes were given out by the local Chapter by way of raffles or drawings. They also reserved Saturday Sept 11th of 2021 for the next Ruffed Grouse shoot at our club.

Re-guarding our Annul meeting, election of Board members and dinner. Due to the Corna Virus, current national concerns and state wide restrictions on gatherings and food service. Our December 5th annual meeting, election of board members and dinner is canceled. The safety of our members is of prime concern. The most difficult issue is dealing with having large gatherings and social distancing. We have determined that our club house is to small and local businesses state that they are currently under staffed for servicing our needs. Our clubs Board of Directors has voted to avoid exposing our members to risk of infection by extending the terms of all current Board Members by one year.

While working on the 7 yd pistol range near the clubs main gate. I found that someone had moved the shooting bench to 50' from the targets. The bench "must remain at 7 yds (21') from the target frames". The berm behind the target frames is not high enough to safely shoot at any distance greater than 7 yds. When sporting clays is closed and work parties are not present, members & their guests can shoot handguns on the clubs west rifle range that has pistol targets located at greater distances.

The 120 acre site is a former ski club and it is one of Michigan's most outstanding shooting sports facilities. You will surely receive a warm welcome from our members in our spacious, recently remodeled, rustic ½ log clubhouse. The fall color view is marvelous from the hill tops.

The sporting clay's course offers 14 summer and 10 winter shooting stations. All using remote controlled, automated high capacity trap machines. Shooters attempt targets from ground level and from elevated shooting stations. Targets are launched across fields, in wood lots and up and downhill from traps at ground level and mounted on the 21' & 32' high target launching towers. Target presentations are changed monthly.

The Sporting Clay's course takes shooters along winding rolling trails on hillsides. The summer trails offer some great scenic views along the way while going up 220' to the top of the former ski hill. Shooters occasionally over look deer and elk on wooded hillsides or in valleys where eagles may be seen flying overhead.

The Skeet & Trap Fields have concrete walks and modern high capacity trap machines with radio signal or voice controls.

5 - Stand Uses seven remote controlled, automated high capacity trap machines.

Archery offers life sized 3-D targets and warm up target bails. It is free during normal club hours.

New members must sign in at the club desk.

Club House Hours: Summer (May 1 to Nov 1) Sat & Sun 10am-3pm. Winter, (Nov 1 to May 1). Open Sundays only 10am-3pm. 200 yd. Rifle & Pistol range is closed Sat. & Sun. May 1st to October 31st and Sundays Nov 1st to April 30th

West Rifle & Pistol Range is closed when the sporting clays course is open.

Sporting Clays Safety, If you plan to work on the sporting clay's course you will have to be sure that the Rifle and Pistol ranges are shut down. You are responsible for your safety and the safety of those you take with you. Place a special notice on the west rifle range gate stating "No shooting ,Work Party Down range".

Rifle & Pistol ranges. Shoot only at targets properly mounted in the center of the black Celotex target backers attached to the frames. Do not shoot at any object setting on or hanging from the wood framework or at any buildings or objects on the sporting clay's course. Someone may be walking or working on the hill and be unaware that the rifle & pistol range is in use.

Hunting and trespassing Due to the fact that members may be involved with any of the clubs shooting sports or maintenance activities at various locations on any given day of the week. It is not considered safe to allow unauthorized activities to take place. At all times the unauthorized use of the clubs property (Including hunting) , buildings, platforms , towers, target throwers, or using motorized vehicles, ATV or snowmobiles on club property in any way is trespassing. **Trespassers will be reported to the local Sheriff's office.**
